## 2023 SUMMER CAMP

The World Peace Game is an immersive self-discovery and learning experience in the form of a geopolitical simulation. Four countries are pitted against each other as players take on the roles of prime ministers, cabinet members, arms dealers, etc. Amongst them is a wily Saboteur who secretly works to undermine world peace. Students face, oil spills, food shortages, political and economic tensions, all while on the brink of armed conflict.

The game is won when students have solved all 50 plus interlinking crises and all countries' net asset values have increased above starting point.

# About the World Peace Game:

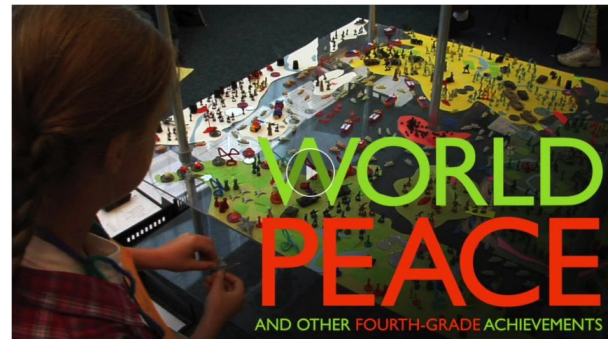
Refined by master teacher John Hunter over the course of 38 years of classroom practice, this experiential learning geopolitical simulation fully engages students' minds as well as hearts. Students must sort through chaos, handle failure, and ultimately look within themselves to decide the right action. They are empowered to do anything they want within the game as long as they can 1) accept the consequences of their decisions 2) afford the financial cost of their actions. No two games are alike, yet every time, the students' own inherent wisdom, creativity, and compassion emerge and save the planet. 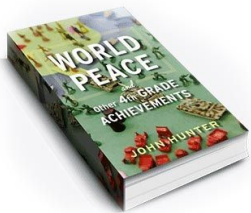
